Chinook Water District Water Supply Restoration Bid Date, February 14, 2012

Notice is hereby given that sealed proposals for the Chinook Water District Water Supply Restoration project will be received by mail only at P.O. Box 191, Chinook, Washington 98614, prior to Tuesday, February 14, 2012. Proposals may also be hand delivered to the Chinook Fire Hall, 764 Highway 101, Chinook Washington, 98614, the day of the bid opening only until **2:00 p.m.** (Local Time) on **Tuesday, February 14, 2012**, and then at the Chinook Fire Hall, publicly opened and read aloud. Proposals received after the time fixed will not be considered.

Bidding documents for the project are prepared by PACE Engineers, Inc.

Bid Schedule:

The proposed work consists of replacing the Owner's aging raw water intakes and failed dam low level outlet with a new combined raw water intake and dam outlet through the existing earthen dam. The project will also remove accumulated sediment from the raw water supply reservoir and haul the spoils to a designated placement site provided by the Owner.

Availability of Bidding Documents: Plans, Specifications and Contract Documents may be examined by appointment only at the water treatment plant of the Chinook Water District, 230 Chinook Valley Road, Chinook, Washington 98614 and obtained at the Issuing Office of PACE Engineers, Inc., 5000 Meadows Road, Suite 345, Lake Oswego, Oregon 97035, upon payment of a \$125 non-refundable fee. An electronic copy on a compact disk (CD) of said documents may be obtained from PACE Engineer's office at the above address upon request. A \$10 non-refundable fee per CD will be charged. Each bid shall be made out on the separate bound Bid Form included with the Contract Documents. Copies of the contract documents may be examined at the following locations: Daily Journal Plan Center, Portland, Oregon; SW Washington Contractors, Vancouver, Washington; Builders Exchange of Washington, Everett, Washington; Valley Plan Center, Inc., Kent, Washington; McGraw-Hill Construction Dodge, Portland, Oregon; Seattle Daily Journal Plan Center, Seattle, Washington; Oregon Contractors, Clackamas, Oregon; McGraw-Hill Construction Data, Seattle, Washington; and the Urban League of Metropolitan Seattle Contractor Development and Competitiveness Center, Seattle, Washington.

Bid Security: Each Bid Proposal shall be accompanied by a certified check, cashier's check, postal money order or Bid Bond (with authorized surety company as surety) made payable to the Chinook Water District in an amount not less than five percent (5%) of the amount of the Bid. The check or Bid Bond shall be given as guarantee that the Bidder shall execute the Contract, if it be awarded to such Bidder, in conformity with the Contract Documents and that the Bidder shall provide Surety Bond or Bonds as specified therein within ten (10) calendar days after notification of the award of the Contract to the Bidder.

The Chinook Water District is an Equal Opportunity and Affirmative Action Employer. Small, Minority- and Women-owned firms are encouraged to submit bids. All work performed on the project will be subject to the higher of prevailing state or federal Davis-Bacon wage rates. This project is funded through the Washington State Community Development Block Grant program with federal funds from the U.S. Department of Housing and Urban Development.

Pre-bid submittals are required as specified in the bidding documents by January 31, 2012 at 5:00 pm at the PACE Engineers office in Lake Oswego, Oregon. Faxed pre-bid submittals will not be accepted.

A mandatory pre-bid conference will be held on January 26, 2012, from 1:00 p.m. to 3:00 p.m. to review the site and answer questions. Transportation will not be provided. The conference will be held at the Chinook Fire Hall, 764 Highway 101, Chinook, Washington 98614.

Rejection of Bids: The Chinook Water District shall have the right to reject any or all bids not accompanied by bid security or data required by the bidding document or a bid in any way incomplete or irregular, and to give particular attention to the qualifications of the Bidder.

No Bidder may withdraw a bid after the hour set for the opening thereof, or before award of Contract, unless said award is delayed for a period exceeding ninety (90) days from the date of bid opening.
